



BLOG GUIDELINES

To encourage teachers to share their best examples of (remote) STEM teaching, our blog is now open for **everyone** who would like to share their stories of **implementation of STEM (online) activities in the (virtual) classroom**. In response to the current situation, we are also very happy to welcome **articles with tips and resources** that teachers use to organise their online classes.

Publishing an online post on our blog will be considered as an activity for the **STEM Discovery Campaign**, therefore, everyone who wants to submit a blog or article first must fill in the Activity Submission Form. After the submission of the form, your activity will be pinned on the **STEM Discovery Campaign activities' map** and we will create an account for you on our blog platform so you can start writing your blog/article.

IF YOU REPORT ON THE (ONLINE) ACTIVITY YOU ALREADY CARRIED OUT. TELL US ABOUT:

- what you did in your activity
- what materials and resources helped you to implement the (online) activity
- how you involved your audience (online)
- the pedagogical value of your activity
- why others should use this or similar methods with their students

Also include:


- a. **Title** of your activity
- b. **Dates** that it took place
- c. Your **name**

All blog posts should be written in **English**, have a **minimum of 300 words** and at least **one picture**.


Important: in case you use pictures or videos where participants' faces are showing, do not forget to ask first for their written permissions in accordance with the provisions of the GDPR. In addition, for persons under the age of 18, you must get their legal guardians' agreement before using their images. We may ask you to provide us with proof of such permission before publishing any entry. **If you are writing an article talking about useful tips and resources**, please specify how certain online tools and resources are/were useful to organise/implement STEM activities virtually.

HOW TO ADD PICTURES OR VIDEOS TO YOUR BLOG?


1. Upload pictures/photos/videos on your **Google Drive**. Please try to **avoid** uploading **dark, blurry, low-resolution** images. Also, please **do not add more than 7** pictures per post.
2. Select the picture (or any visual material) you want to include in your blog post, click the right mouse button and press **Share**.




3. From the menu bar select **Anyone with the link can view**.




4. Press **Copy link** and copy the hyperlink that appears below.



5. In WordPress click **Add image**.



6. Paste the previously copied hyperlink in the **Upload URL** field.
