SCIENTIX 3 COMPETITION: STEM DISCOVERY WEEK 'MAKE YOUR OWN POSTER'

1. Competition Schedule: Submitted proposals for the competition are accepted from **17 March, 2017 at 00:01 A.M. Central European Time to 23 April 2017 at 11:59 P.M. Central European Time**. The official competition runs for the duration of the **STEM Discovery Week from 24 April at 00:01 A.M. Central European Time to 4 May 2017 11:59 P.M. Central European Time**.

2. Eligibility: Participation in the Competition is subject to these Rules and decisions made by the Scientix project team, which are final and binding in all respects and not subject to appeal.

The competition is open only to primary school and secondary STEM teachers with a legal residence in one of these countries.

3. To Enter: During the submission period of the competition, **participants can submit their posters, which should showcase their favourite Scientix Resources, the reasons they chose these resources and the way they use them for teaching.**

The participants should create their own poster and show how they use their favourite resources to stimulate their STEM lessons. Each participant can create **up to 5 posters** and choose as many resources as they like. Then they should post their poster on their public account and include the hashtag **#ScientixPoster** on one of the following social media channels:

(1) Twitter

- If you are uploading a photo to Twitter, be sure to follow [@scientix_eu](https://twitter.com/scientix_eu), https://twitter.com/scientix_eu and to include the hashtag **#ScientixPoster**. Your post is limited to 140 characters.

(2) Facebook

- If posting photo/video on Facebook, join the group: <https://www.facebook.com/groups/ScienceTeachersEurope> and post on its wall by using "write a post", add the hashtag **#ScientixPoster** and uploading the poster on it. Add a description of less than 50 words to describe the background and content of your post.

(3) Instagram

- If uploading a photo to Instagram, be sure to follow Scientix [@scientix_eu](https://www.instagram.com/scientix_eu/) https://www.instagram.com/scientix_eu/. Publish your poster and add the competition hashtag **#ScientixPoster** and a description of less than 140 characters.

All posters must be posted/submitted by the end of 23 April 2017 in order to be eligible for the competition. On 24 April 2017, all contributions will be uploaded to the competition page on the Scientix portal and the OFFICIAL voting will begin.

4. Entry Restrictions: There is a **limit of five posters** submitted per person. DO NOT post/submit the same photo more than once; this includes sending a submission via multiple social media channels. A given social media or e-mail account may only be used by one person to participate in the competition. Any dispute as to identity any of the prize winners will be resolved by Scientix in its sole discretion.

5. Content Restrictions: Submitted content must comply with the following criteria:

- (a) Content must be original and not copied, as a whole or partly, from any other source;
- (b) Content must have been created specifically for this competition and not previously published;
- (c) Content must be truthful;
- (d) Content must not violate the rights of any third party;
- (e) Content must not be inappropriate or unfit for publication (e.g., include nudity, obscenity or hate speech);
- (f) Content must not show faces of underage students.

6. Licence of the content: Entrant accepts that the submitted content follows a Creative Commons License of Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike 4.0 International (CC BY-NC-SA 4.0). Details of this license can be found at: <https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc-sa/4.0/>

7. Selection of Winners: At the end of the competition period, Scientix evaluators will select two submissions as winners based on the following criteria:

- (a) highest number of Facebook likes.
- (b) highest number of retweets.

If there are more than two participants with the same score in likes or retweets, Scientix evaluators will select two submissions as winners based on the following criteria:

- (a) how well the submission captures the essence of the competition's theme
- (b) the quality of the submission (25%)
- (c) the innovation of idea and design (25%).

If there are more than one like of the same poster, Scientix evaluators will take into account the post with the highest number of likes/retweets, and NOT the sum of likes/retweets from all the posts of the same poster.

8. Notification of Winners: Potential winners will be contacted by the Scientix evaluators according to their method of submission:

- (a) If potential winner participated via Twitter, he/she will be notified via direct message from @scientix_eu.
- (b) If potential winner participated via Facebook, a Scientix representative on Facebook will post a comment on his/her Submission and/or via private message.

It is the entrant's sole responsibility to assure that his/her social media account settings will allow for Scientix to contact him/her should he/she be selected as a potential winner in the competition. In all cases, in order to remain eligible to win a prize, winner must respond to the winner notification contact (i.e, email or comment, as the case may be) and commence the prize claim procedure within 48 hours of transmission/posting of contact. In the event of noncompliance with these requirements, if potential winner cannot be reached for any reason (including failure to receive or respond to contact for any reason) or if potential winner is determined to be ineligible or otherwise in violation of these Terms and Conditions, he/she shall be disqualified and forfeit the prize. In case of prize forfeiture, alternate winner(s) will be selected.

10. Prize.

Authors of awarded contributions in this competition will be invited to a [Science Projects Workshop in Brussels, Belgium, between 23 and 25 June 2017](#). Scientix will organise and cover the winners' flight to/from Brussels (up to 400 EUR) and accommodation on Friday and Saturday night in Brussels.

Prizes will be limited to only one person per winning submission, the one that submitted the content in his/her account. No prize substitution is allowed.

Flights will be only covered for countries eligible for participation in the competition.

Scientix will not reimburse any airline tickets purchased individually. Any other costs like to/from airport, local transport and/or travel insurance is at the participants' expense.

11. Releases: By accepting a prize, the winner allows Scientix to use his/her name to disseminate the results of the competition. In case of any problems during the running of the competition, Scientix keeps the right to modify any of the previous conditions.
