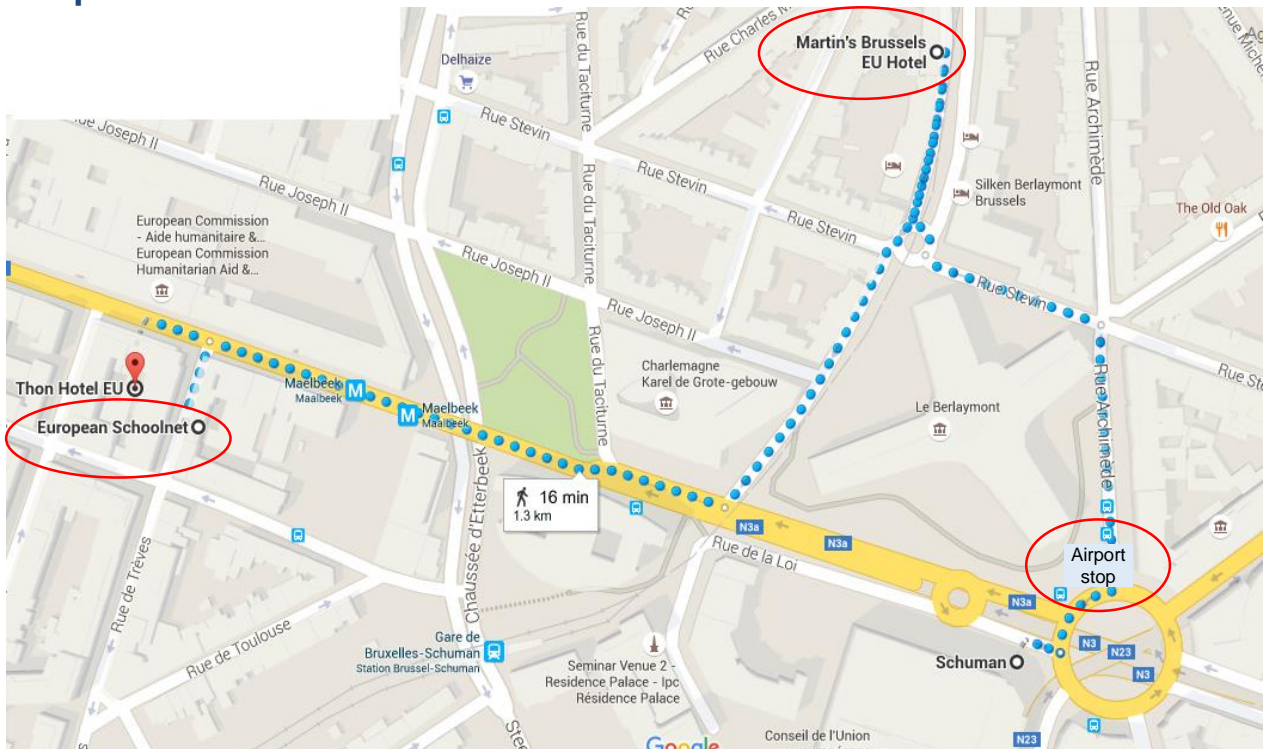

DINNER ON SATURDAY

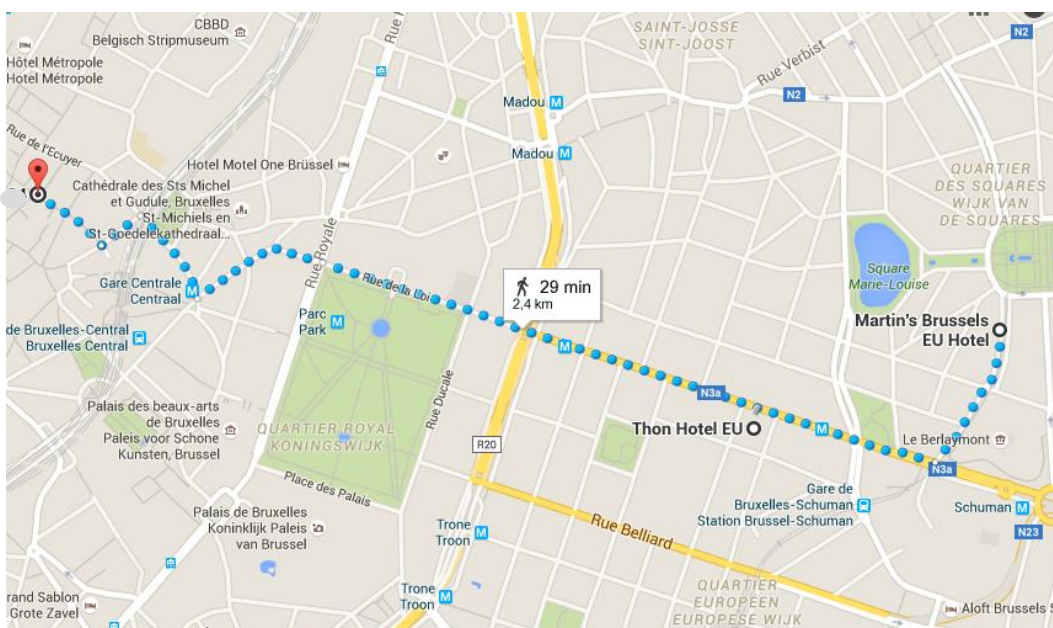
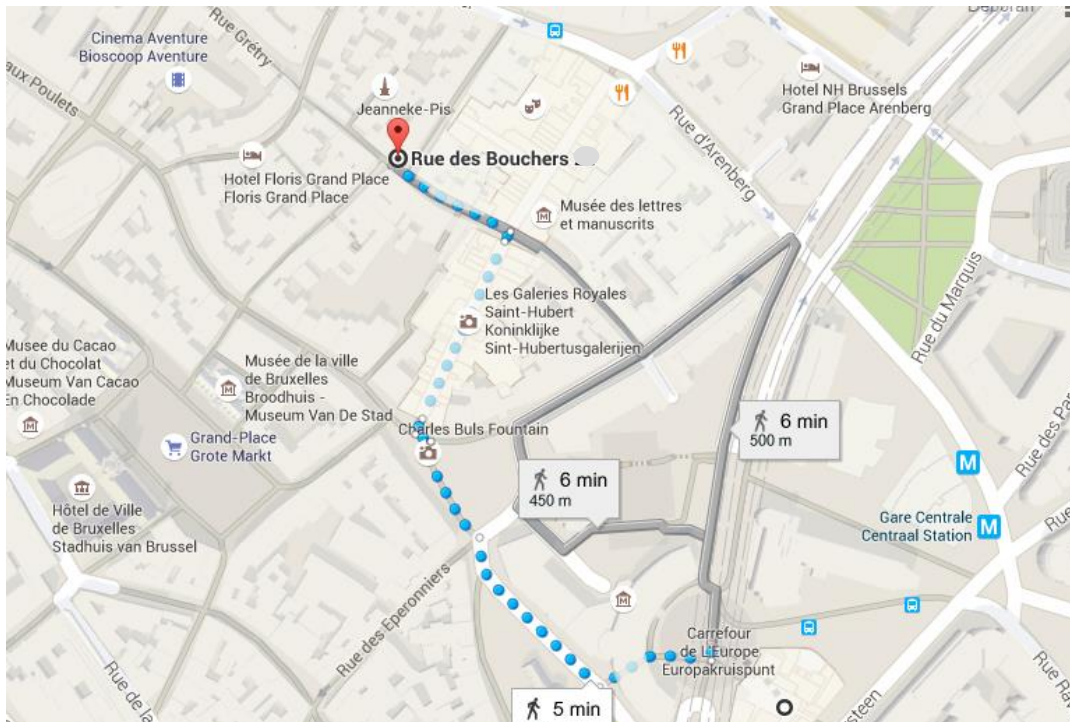
