How it went? Recommendations



Science Escape Room.

“Who of us does not like secrets and riddles. And as Karel Čapek wrote: “Get to know – it’s a mystery.”

There was an accident in one of the laboratories of the future. An unspecified organ system broke into pieces and with it scientists were trapped in the room. Using the acquired knowledge, participants of the game cooperate with each other to find hidden puzzles, solve them, recreate the damaged layout, find the lost key and get out of the laboratory. The ally of this game are of course ICT tools.



Suggestions for others.

Students receive instructions at the beginning. They work as a group for success. The coordinator explains that in various places in the hall there are hidden tasks (organs) to be found. In addition to solving puzzles, students also find the room key.

Learning through play using modern technologies and free software can be an interesting variation on school boredom for use on every subject.
