

Competitions "Fables on Climate" and "Fables on Gender Equality"

- For children resident in EU aged 6-12 years old
- Open until 31 May 2021
- Announcement of winners by the Jury mid June 2021

The competition allows children to use their creativity and their artistic and scientific skills to:

- Create an original fable on climate or gender equality of max 200 words with a "morale" at the end
- Illustrate it with comic strip of 2-10 frames with at least 2 colors
- Bonus for multicultural and teamwork









Competitions "Art & Science on Climate" and "Art & Science on Gender Equality"

- For teenagers resident in EU aged 13-18 years old
- Open until 31 May 2021
- Announcement of winners by the Jury mid June 2021









Competitions "Art & Science on Climate" and "Art & Science on Gender Equality"

The competition allows teenagers to use their creativity and their artistic and scientific skills to:

- Create an original work integrating one art topic (eg music, dance, sculpture, drawing, painting)
 and one scientific topic (eg energy, transport, aeronautics, biology, ICT) on climate or gender
 equality, addressing the issue and possibly proposing a solution, which should:
- be made in physical material or multimedia/digital means (picture, video), and can consist of: drawing or painting; novel, story or poem; music or dance performance; handicraft or sculpture; project design or any other creative work;
 - be inspiring for people;
 - be completely original and not contain any third party's work;
 - be possibly done by participating children in a team and in the context of a class activity
